Net sales of completed construction contracts and profits exceeded the results of the same period of the previous year.

Non-consolidated net sales of completed construction contracts

Net sales of completed construction contracts increased by \(\xi\)3,761 million to \(\xi\)117,290 million (up 3.3% year on year).

Net sales of completed construction contracts by customers, The Kansai Electric Power Company, Incorporated (including Kansai Transmission and Distribution, Inc.) increased by \$1,370 million to \$21,868 million (up 6.7% year on year), The Kansai Electric Power Group increased by \$216 million to \$3,857 million (up 5.9% year on year), and Others increased by \$2,174 million to \$91,565 million (up 2.4% year on year).

Net sales of completed construction contracts by construction sector, Power Distribution Lining increased by ¥1,426 million to ¥19,650 million (up 7.8% year on year), Electrical increased by ¥649 million to ¥73,308 million (up 0.9% year on year), Information & Communications Network increased by ¥932 million to ¥8,261 million (up 12.7% year on year), Environmental Management Facilities increased by ¥779 million to ¥11,613 million (up 7.2% year on year), and Electric Power & Others decreased by ¥26 million to ¥4,456 million (down 0.6% year on year). The main factors contributing to the increase in Power Distribution Lining were an increase in the volume of construction work by Kansai Transmission and Distribution, Inc., while the main factors behind the increase in Electrical were an increase in factories, etc. The main factors behind the increase in Information & Communications Network were increases in local area network, etc., while the main factors behind the increase in Environmental Management Facilities were an increase in office buildings, etc. The main factors behind the decrease in Electric Power & Others were decreases in work on power plants and substations, etc.

Non-consolidated construction orders

Construction orders increased by ¥19,770 million to ¥266,625 million (up 8.0% year on year).

Construction orders by customers, The Kansai Electric Power Company, Incorporated (including Kansai Transmission and Distribution, Inc.) increased by \$1,384 million to \$24,060 million (up 6.1% year on year), The Kansai Electric Power Group increased by \$2,039 million to \$6,605 million (up 44.7% year on year), and Others increased by \$16,345 million to \$235,960 million (up 7.4% year on year).

Construction orders by construction sector, Power Distribution Lining increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{1,347}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{21}}}{21,774}\) million (up 6.6% year on year), Electrical decreased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{1,910}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{15,947}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{20,429}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{2,429}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{2,885}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{22,865}\) million (up 14.4% year on year), and Electric Power & Others increased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{15,017}\) million to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{30,530}\) million (up 96.8% year on year). The main factors contributing to the increase in

Power Distribution Lining were an increase in the volume of construction by Kansai Transmission and Distribution, Inc., while the main factors behind the decrease in Electrical were a decrease in educational and cultural facilities, factories, etc., despite increases in office buildings, etc. The main factors behind the increase in Information & Communications Network were increases in local area network, etc., while the main factors behind the increase in Environmental Management Facilities were increases in logistics facilities, etc. The main factors behind the increase in Electric Power & Others were increases in work on power plants and substations, etc.

(2) Overview of financial position for the period

Assets

Current assets decreased by \$78,961 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \$424,694 million (down 15.7% from the end of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly due to a decrease in notes receivable, accounts receivable from completed construction contracts and other resulting from the collection of construction costs. Cash on hand (cash and cash equivalents) decreased by \$20,260 million to \$164,401 million.

Non-current assets increased by \$31,120 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \$349,157 million (up 9.8% from the end of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly due to an increase in goodwill.

As a result, total assets decreased by $\frac{47,841}{100}$ million from the end of the previous fiscal year to $\frac{4773,852}{100}$ million (down 5.8% from the end of the previous fiscal year).

Liabilities

Current liabilities decreased by ¥45,883 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥156,574 million (down 22.7% from the end of the previous fiscal year). The main factors behind the decrease were a decrease in notes payable, accounts payable for construction contracts and other due to progress made in paying trade payables on material costs, etc. and a decrease in income taxes payable due to payment of income taxes, etc.

Non-current liabilities increased by ¥5,294 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥24,792 million (up 27.2% from the end of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly due to an increase in asset retirement obligations.

As a result, total liabilities decreased by 440,588 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to 181,367 million (down 18.3% from the end of the previous fiscal year).

Net assets

Shareholders' equity decreased by \(\frac{\pmathb{\text{\pmathb{\text{\generation}}}}{837}\) million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \(\frac{\pmathb{\text{\pmathb{\pmathb{\text{\generation}}}}{1600}\) from the end of the previous fiscal year), due to the recording of profit attributable to owners of parent, dividends of surplus and purchase of treasury shares. Non-controlling interests were \(\frac{4}{24}\) million (down 10.1\% from the end of the previous fiscal year).

As a result, net assets decreased by \$7,252 million from the end of the previous fiscal year to \$592,485 million (down 1.2% from the end of the previous fiscal year). Equity-to-asset ratio was 76.5%, an increase of 3.6 percentage points from the end of the previous fiscal year.

(3) Explanation of consolidated earnings forecast and other forward-looking statements

The consolidated earnings forecast for the current fiscal year is unchanged from the forecast announced on April 25, 2025.

(4) Other

The Company acquired all the issued shares of KITA KOUDENSHA Corporation from Mitsubishi Electric Corporation on April 1, 2025, making it a consolidated subsidiary from this first quarter under review.
